1.	OBLIGATIONS OF THE CARRIER
	<p>1. make sure that the dangerous goods being transported are approved for carriage in accordance with ADR</p> <p>2. make sure that the driver has a valid authorization to transport dangerous goods</p> <p>3. affix the safety signs and prescribed markings to the vehicle</p> <p>4. provide the vehicle with written instructions in the event of an accident to the driver (located in the vehicle before loading).</p>
2.	USED TRANSPORT PACKAGING
	<p>Dangerous substances must be transported in packaging declared in the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR). It is recommended to use packaging that is impermeable, sealable and chemically resistant to the relevant hazardous substance.</p> <p>For the needs of transport of medical and clinical waste according to ADR, the packaging for the purposes of piece transport is transferred to plastic one-piece bellows without the packaging code, resp. ADR certificate.</p>

3.	ACCIDENT
3.1.	<p>Leakage of petroleum products from vehicles In this case, it is a leak of petroleum products from vehicles (oils, lubricants).</p> <p>Although these accidents do not have a significant impact on people's lives and health, they have a significant impact on the environment. Petroleum products can enter the sewage system as well as the soil. This accident can occur due to impact, collision, leakage, negligence, sabotage. In the event of a situation, the driver, resp. the person responsible for the premises shall carry out the necessary activities to cope with the accident as soon as it is identified. If it is a major accident, the dispatcher (in case the leak occurred during transport), ADR safety consultant and company manager is informed. Subsequently, the fire and rescue corps will be called to eliminate the accident.</p> <p>In the event of a minor accident, removal of petroleum products by own means (vapex, sawdust, broom, spatula impermeable container) with processing of the record of removal of the accident and subsequent records of the accident.</p> <p>} Vehicle fire In these cases, it is a serious accident. Fire can occur from electrical installations, the deposition of fine dust on electrical installations, electrical equipment, machinery, heat radiating equipment, open flames. A fire can endanger the health and lives of people in the affected building as well as damage and endanger neighboring buildings. From the above facts, the documentation of fire protection and fire control is comprehensively processed. Combustion releases heat, which can result in the spread of fire to neighboring areas, as well as combustion products (carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide, hydrogen cyanide, nitrogen oxides, sulfur ash), which both pollute the environment and endanger people's health and lives.</p>

	In the event of a vehicle fire while driving, it is the driver's responsibility to immediately park the vehicle on the curbs and call the fire and rescue service to eliminate the fire.
3.3.	<p>Leakage of chemicals</p> <p>In this case, it is a leakage of chemicals from the container - damage or spillage of the chemical during handling</p> <p>Although the accident does not have a significant impact on the environment, it can harm human health. Chemicals can enter the sewage system as well as the soil. This accident can occur due to impact, collision, leakage, negligence, sabotage.</p> <p>In the event of a situation, the person responsible for the premises will perform the necessary activities to cope with the accident immediately upon discovery. If it is a major accident, the dispatcher (in case the leak occurred during transport), ADR safety consultant and company manager is informed. Subsequently, the fire and rescue corps will be called to eliminate the accident.</p> <p>In the event of a minor accident, the removal of chemical substances by our own means (chemical emergency kit, impermeable container) with the processing of a record of the removal of the accident and the subsequent registration of the accident.</p> <p>Vehicle failure, resp. The situation that prevents the delivery of goods by the vehicle is described in chap. 8 - SM 05 Market withdrawal and crisis management. A detailed procedure for rectifying the emergency situation is included in Annex 2 to this Directive.</p> <p>Written instructions are provided to assist in the event of an emergency in the event of an accident involving dangerous goods which may occur or arise during transport. These must be located in the driver's cab and must be easily accessible. Written instructions to the driver are given by the carrier, based on information on the dangerous substance. Written instructions are given in Annex 3 to this Directive.</p>
